

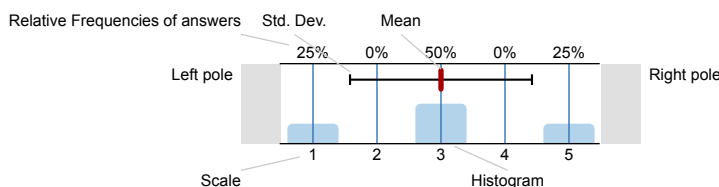

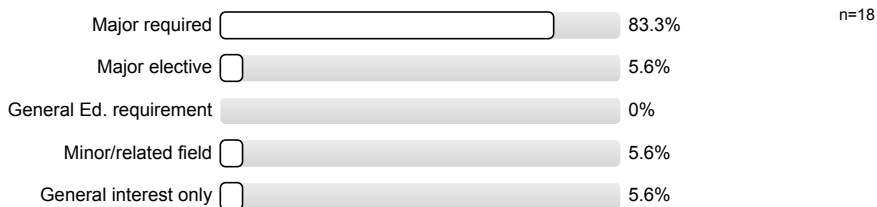

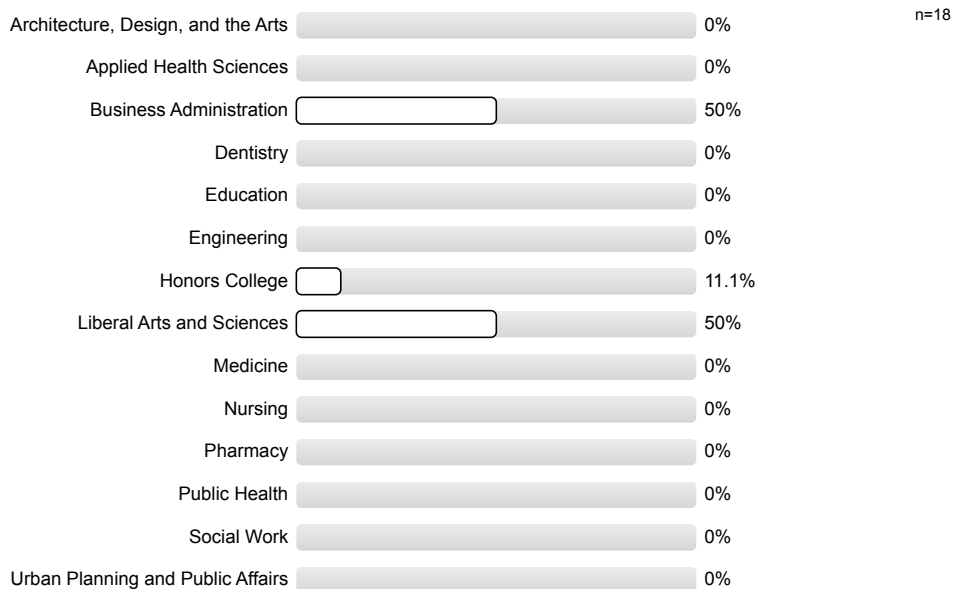
2.2) Primary Reason for taking the course



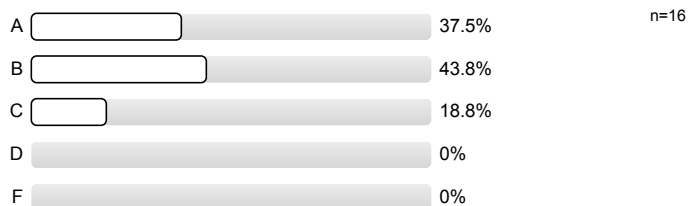
